Rotary 4-Way Test Speech Competition

Senior Kurt Yochum won the Hillsboro Rotary Club 4-Way Test Speech competition during the Rotary Luncheon at the Hillsboro Ponderosa, Tuesday, April 18. He will receive a prize of \$150. Kurt competed against students from Hillsboro, Fairfield and West Union to take the top spot in the annual event. He will speak again at the District Competition at Wittenberg University April 6 where the prize for first place is \$600. Second place at District wins \$400; third wins \$250, and fourth wins \$150.

Kurt's speech focused on how he used the

Rotarians' 4-Way Test to resolve a problem in his life. The test, which was created by a businessman in 1932, requires one to ask four questions before making a decision: Is it the truth; Is it fair to all concerned? Will it build goodwill and better friendships; Is it beneficial to all concerned?

Kurt receives \$100 for winning at Whiteoak. Kasey Sosby was the first runner-up and will receive \$75; Heather Brewer was second runner-up and will receive \$50. All the contestants enjoyed lunch at the Ponderosa on Tuesday. They included
