Tornado Season Continues.

Though tornado season is April through August, tornados can touch down any time during the year. Ohio is at the eastern edge of what is known as "Tornado Alley." Ohio experiences an average of 16 tornados per year. Highland County has experienced 13 tornados which have caused no deaths; Adams County has experienced 10, causing 1 death; Brown County has experienced 11, causing 1 death; Clinton County had 15, causing 2 deaths; Fayette County had 7, causing 1; Ross had 8, causing no deaths, and Pike had 3, causing no deaths.
