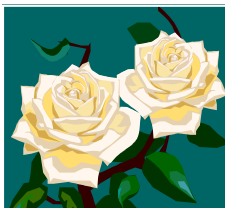

CURRENT EVENTS

Tropical Storm Fay hammered Florida last Tuesday, bringing twenty-five inches of rain near Melbourne Beach, Florida. It has taken four days to cross the state, hitting it three times. The death toll from the storm is thirty-six. There have been eleven deaths in Florida, one in Georgia, and twenty-three in Haiti. It is one of the top rainmakers to hit the state since 1950 according to the federal Hydrometeorological Prediction Center. Tropical Storm Amelia produced the heaviest single rainfall in 1978 with 48 inches at Medina, Texas.
