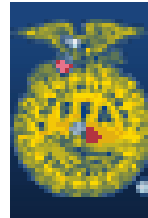

On Monday, March 29, a pair of deadly Chechen suicide bombers struck two Moscow subway stations during rush hour. At least 39 people have been killed, with more than 60 wounded. Russian-Chechen assaults have been dated back to about 20 years and since then, thousands have been killed and more than 500,000 Chechens have been displaced from their land.
