you to the I Team! They provided the snacks, drinks, and pizza for the dance. We also want to say thank-you to Bailey, Kendra, and Danielle for running the music!

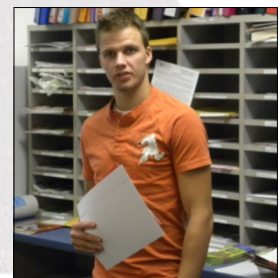


Senior Spotlight

A NATO helicopter crashed in southern Afghanistan Monday, killing nine service members. The cause of the crash is currently unknown and under investigation, but the Taliban has already claimed to have shot it down. The incident was the worst chopper crash for the American forces in four years, and marked 2010 as the deadliest year of the Afghan War for foreign forces. So far this year, 525 U.S. and NATO troops have been killed in Afghanistan, already surpassing the 504 killed last year.

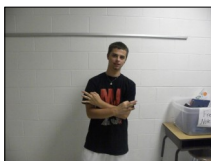

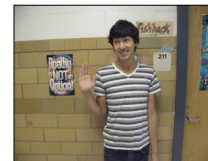
